

## Clarification on the ILS OTEP Plan for 2022 and 2023 AEMT and IV Endorsement

1. The state of Washington DOH has approved Yakima County to adopt the Benton/Franklin County OTEP plan for 2022 and 2023.
2. **AEMT and IV** endorsed providers will complete all BLS level OTEP didactic and skills labs as outlined.
  - This is a quarterly requirement per DOH 530-234 and WAC 246-976-163.
3. Additional ILS skills are listed for the Workshops and must be completed. (Please notify the EMS office when an EMT-IV Endorsed or AEMT will be attending, to ensure we send the appropriate level instructor and equipment).
4. **IV Endorsed** providers are encouraged, but not required to attend the quarterly MPD meetings or complete these online in Ninth Brain afterwards. **This training does count towards maintaining NREMT.**
  - Regardless of attending live or completing afterwards, a quiz is mandatory to receive credit.
4. **AEMT** providers **must** participate in the quarterly MPD meetings.
  - There are 4 MPD meetings per year.
  - **2 must be attended live (via ZOOM)**
  - All 4 MPD meetings are uploaded to Ninth Brain for those who were not able to attend or watch live
  - All AEMT providers must take the MPD Lecture quiz in Ninth Brain for each MPD meeting, regardless of attending live or completing afterwards. **The quiz is mandatory to receive credit.**
5. In addition to the above, **AEMT** providers must successfully complete and/or maintain an HCP CPR card.
  - It is recommended, but not required, that **IV endorsed providers** maintain a BLS CPR card through a nationally recognized organization.

The above meets the MPD and WADOH standard for recertification via OTEP method.

Any other training such as EMS Connect or Vector Solutions, **(during 2019-2021 it is mandatory as it was part of your WA DOH approved OTEP)** is above and beyond and strongly encouraged.
