3	Attendance is tracked at the lectures. If you are attending over Zoom, please make sure to put your name in the "chat" and "Yakima County" to ensure you are not missed.
4	Full credit for the lectures will be given once the quiz is completed (this will be available in Ninth Brain)
5	For those who attended the lecture live, you may skip the videos and go straight to the quiz. An 80% or better is required for a passing grade.
6	For those who did not attend the lecture "live", you must watch the videos and then successfully complete the quiz with an 80% or better.
